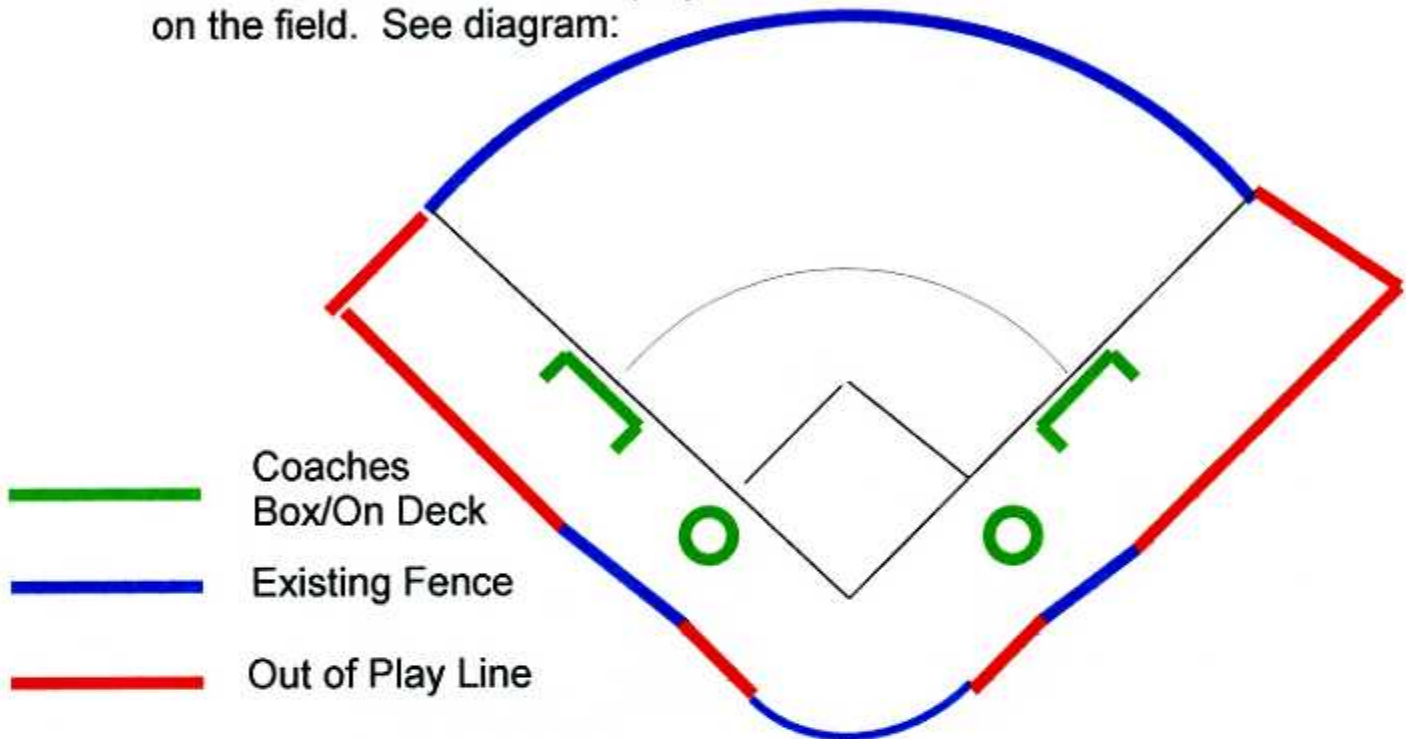


SAYRE LITTLE LEAGUE JUNIOR/SENIOR FIELD GROUND RULES

From the end of each dugout, an out of play line is drawn straight beginning at the pole of the dugout. Once this line meets up with the distance of the outfield fence the line will cut in and meet up with the fence. This out of play area is marked with a white line on the field. See diagram:



There are no fences to the “gate” of the dugout, so therefore they are marked with an “out of play line” as well.

Should a ball go out of play – book rule.

Should a ball hit the tree in left field in the air, it shall be ruled a home run.

Should a ball get stuck in the fence behind home plate, or in the outfield fence, players should raise their hands and play will be determined by the umpires.

Coaches **MUST** remain in their coaching boxes, and players on deck **MUST** remain in the on deck circles as shown above.
